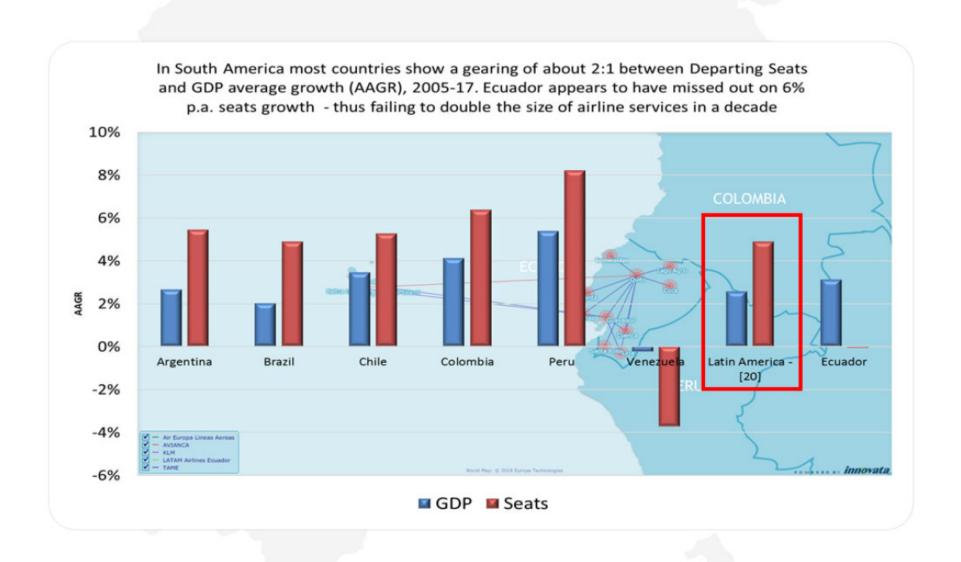

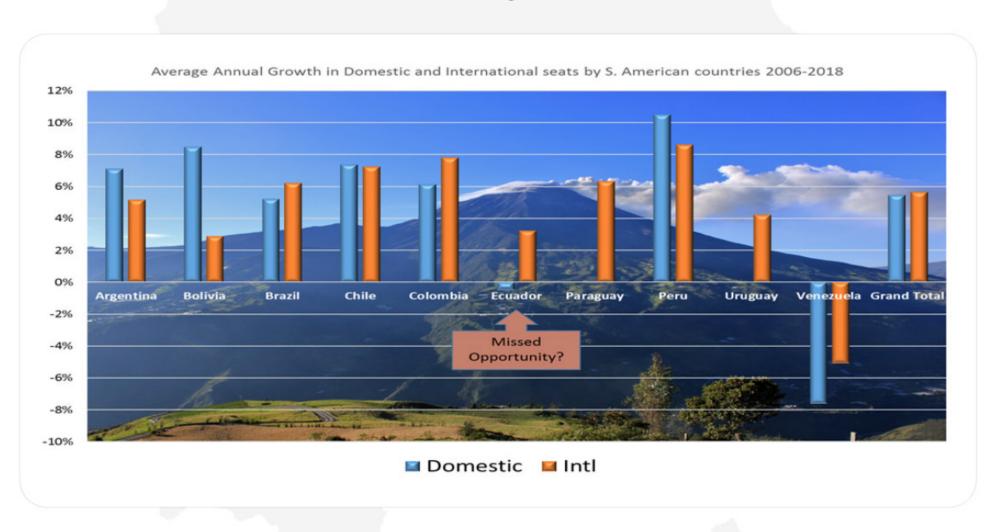


Ecuador has missed out on Aviation growth





Domestic air seats evolution Routes have reduced, despite GDP and tourism growth



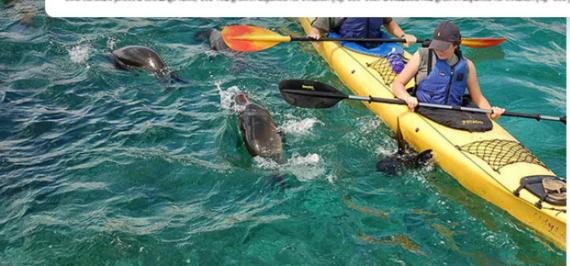


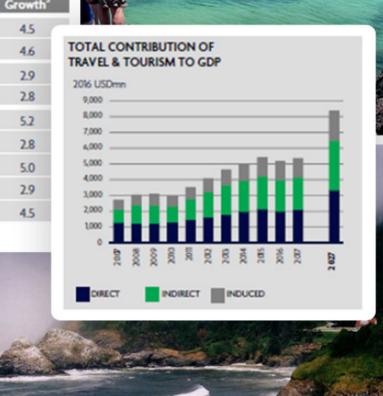
Ecuador Tourism- Future Growth

Market opportunity



Ecuador GDP averaging growth circa 3% / year, on par with rest of South America, for the last decade, despite the recent recession GDP growth brings aviation growth. Ecuador aviation market has lost 10+ years of traffic growth from lack of competition, high fares, and inefficiency.

The growth of tourism and mineral industries requires efficient air transport. Ecuador domestic air travel markets particularly inhibited, and only half the size they should be, compared with Peru and Colombia. [If Galapagos domestic routes are excluded, decline on the mainland is even worse].

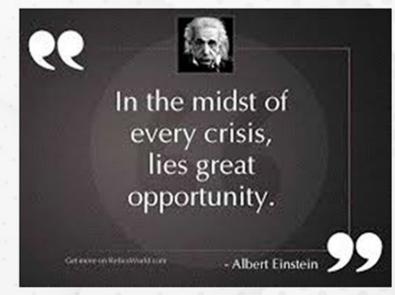
Government keen to promote aviation growth

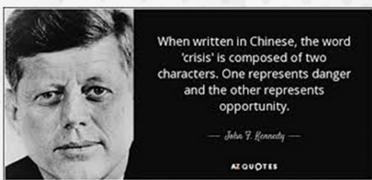
Market opportunity for a new airline to identify and satisfy unmet demand. Generate new air service between key locations, particularly catering for domestic business and tourist traffic



Post COVID-19 opportunities

- Domestic routes are essential "social routes"
 Stimulate local economy & trade.
- International tourism will gravitate to less-crowded destinations like Ecuador and Galapagos Islands which already has a 50% capacity on cruise ships and on certain islands
- Ecuador offers excellent value and a variety of activities for low, middle, and upper-income tourists.
- Focus on tourism. Oil industry plummets. Re-focus on tourism, hospitality and gastronomy to support economy & recovery.
- Eco/Exotic tourism had seen a 13% increase (Sky Magazine March 2016) prior to the COVID outbreak. Predicted rise 2021.

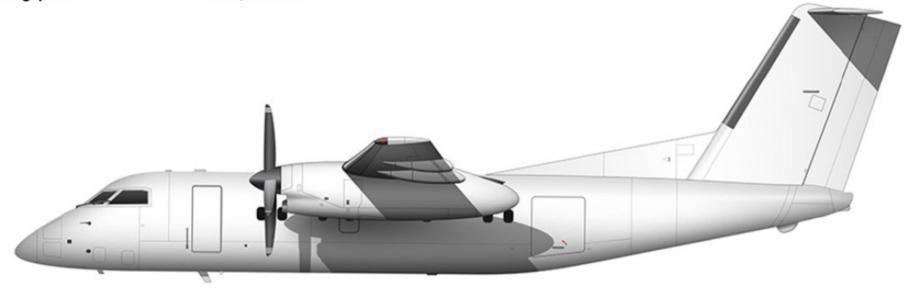
